

# FLIP THE SWITCH



[Senate Bill 2001](#) was passed in a two-day special session in 2025 with the blessing of the Governor and the Mississippi Legislature. This secret deal between Entergy and Amazon:

*Strips Public Service Commission oversight  
Greenlights Unlimited Spending for Entergy  
Subsidizes Amazon's Madison County Data Center Project*

## CITES FROM [SENATE BILL 2001](#):

- 22(8)(b) says costs that are identified and recorded by Entergy's accountants are presumed prudent. No PSC approval required for spending on plants, transmission lines, substations, or other projects for Amazon. No used and useful tests. Entergy gets its cost-plus-10% before the project works and even if it never works.
- 22(7) removes requirement for competitive bids for Entergy's projects related to Amazon. So Entergy's cronies with high bids get the job. Entergy marks their prices up 10% for its guaranteed profit.
- 22(8)(f) allows Entergy to put its padded costs, plus interest on them, into customers' rates before projects are operational.
- 22(8)(h) removes caps on cost recovery, plus interest.
- 22(3)(a-d) allows Entergy to make a "large customer agreement" whose terms can be set without reference to existing laws and locked in place for the life of the agreement and immune from PSC modifications even if costs increase more than provided for in the agreement. And the whole deal is secret — a permanent trade secret
